I can't say it enough, all of you **THANK YOU VERY MUCH!!!**

Joseph Wuni:

In the meanwhile I did not sit still and I can tell you that I met Joseph Wuni! Joseph Wuni is the person where I am going to live and work. A Ghanaian man who has an important function in the community of Chera, the surrounding villages and chairman is from the Ghana Holland Platform. For 6 weeks he was in Holland to be at the meetings from the Holland Ghana Platform, to inform everybody how the projects are doing in Ghana and besides that to take courses! Joseph has given me more information about Chera and ofcourse we talked about the work that I am going to do in Chera. I also informed how Joseph started this work...

The work of Joseph Wuni:

Joseph comes from the village Chera in the North of Ghana. In that village where since years a lot of problems with food. The woman couldn't give enough breast feeding, because themselves had also not enough food. Joseph wanted to change the situation! He already was busy himself, when he met a Dutch man who told him you can also get milk from the goats instead only from the cows to feed the baby's. Important news because the cows in Northern Ghana barely have enough milk for their own calf's. And besides that, goatmilk resembles almost 100% with mothermilk!

With this Dutch man Joseph started a project: buying the good race goats, to breed, keep them in good health, produce milk, ect. When the project went well in Chera, they moved together to the South to start the same project.

But after a while Joseph wanted to go back again to the North, going home where help was more needed. Besides the milkproject Joseph found further development important. Because he thinks children are the future he wanted to start a school. Joseph got in touch with Dutch people and with help of them he started a school! That's how Joseph started this work. Joseph knows the needs, has the knowledge, the Dutch people have the money and other knowledge. Thanks to this cooperation a lot of projects started: the school, the waterpumps project, schooling how people can build their land better, projects to learn to work together, foodprojects and much more! I can tell you more about it later.

Joseph himself is not so well fortunate, but in spite of that he did a lot of good work and is very important for the community. All the projects started with the help of Dutch people and are taken over by Ghanaian people as well the work as the financial part.

When you read the stories on the website you can see these projects are really making progress and go on, also when the Dutch people leave these projects!

Project Kirsten Jonker:

I start working on the only school in the whole surrounding area, who is built by Joseph and the Dutch people. This school has 6 classes, 2 for the little ones and 4 higher levels. In one class are too many children and there is only one teacher. The level of the classes are not very

high and there a lot of children who are not able to follow the lessons, because they are disabled and need special attention. My mainwork is to give those children extra attention, extra and special help. But I am also going to help the teachers, to see together how we can give the lessons in a better way, how we can handle the order and peace in the class etc.

A few people donated schoolbooks (Math and English), really usefull for my project in Ghana! So, when you clean your house and find some books, those are welcome!!! Specially writing material!

An other important function:

Futher I have an other important function. As you know I am affiliated by an official organization ELPG, who is working together with all the organization of the Holland Ghana Platform. My job is to keep up the communication between Ghana and Holland, while there are no Dutch people in the North of Ghana from the Platform. So I am going to inform the people in Holland how the projects are doing, starting in Chera and who knows I can extant it. The organization 'Pomping is Living' arranged a computer for me to use, so I can communicate with Holland easier! Knowing that there is no electricity in Chera, the computer is standing in the next bigger village Wale Wale.

The start!

I have, as you can read, enough work to do! This is the beginning and I hope I can do, with your support and in coöperation with Joseh, much much more good work.

Date of departure!

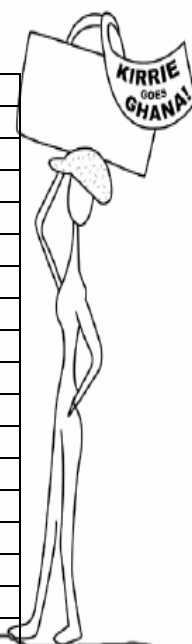
I can also tell you that I am leaving at September 10th to Ghana!!!! After almost two years fighting and thanks to your help, I can finally make my dream come true!
